Welcome at Grossglockner ULTRA-TRAIL® 2017

A very warm welcome to all trail runners and friends of mountain sports!

We are happy and proud to present you the 3rd edition of one of the most difficult and impressive ULTRA-TRAILS in the eastern Alps and kindly invite you to take part in one of the greatest adventures with us, no matter if you are an athlete, spectator or team-member. We want to express our gratitude to all our sponsors and partners, without whom this event would not be possible.

We improved all races and the whole event on several details and further developed it. Completely new in 2017 is the "Taste of the "GGUT regions" at our supply stations, our GGUT Testival at the Expo and our studio "GGUT Live" in Kaprun, including live reports from on FB / Web plus extended Live Tracking. More on that on the following pages.

The highlights remain: The route of GGUT 110 will again lead you over 110 km and

6500 m altitude climb around Austria's highest mountain, the Grossglockner (3798m). Runners are crossing three Austrian provinces and seven valleys, passing 14 glaciers while being surrounded by more than 300 summits higher than 3000 m. Last year Gerald Fister and Florian Grasel crossed the finish line together after 15 hours and 13 minutes. Kristin Berglund came back as the first lady after 18 hours and 43 minutes. We are already curious who will be the first back again in Kaprun this year. But it will be very competitive this year: More than 1000 runners from more than 35 nations will share the adventure with you. Among them several national or international top runners.

We wish you a lot of fun, amazing adventures and a safe return. See you in July at the start line or along the track in Kaprun, Kals am Grossglockner and Uttendorf!



Tracking will be provided via a separate web-platform and will be available in the DATASPORT Event App. In combination with your various intermediate times in the DATASPORT Event App your friends and family may always see where you are moving – either at home or at the event.

For all participants GGUT 110 und GGUT 110 I 2 live tracking is obligatory. Live tracking for these runners functions with a tracker provided by the organiser (combined with a cash deposit). For runners at GGT 50 und GWT Live Tracking is optional, and operates with your own Smartphone.



Grossglockner ULTRA-TRAIL® (GGUT) mainly follows the trails of the so-called "Glocknerrunde" around Austria's highest mountain, the Großglockner (3798 m). Grossglockner ULTRA-TRAIL® 110 is an extremely challenging and difficult trail running competition, leading mostly through difficult alpine territory and mostly higher than 2000 m, 1 time higher than 2800 m and 3 times higher than 2500 m. Expect 2 - 4 larger snowfields to cross, under bad weather conditions even more. For the largest part the track leads over trails (80 %), which are (partwise very) difficult. Bad weather conditions (low temperatures, rainfall, snow) and the night make the race even harder.

Trails are in average very technical. The hardest parts will be the trails up to and down the high mountain passes: to Untere Pfandlscharte (2663 m), Wiener Höhenweg and Pfortscharte (2828 m), Kalser Tauern (2518 m) and Kapruner Törl (2639 m), as well as down from Rudolfshütte and (partwise) down from the Kapruner Hochgebirgsstauseen.



Glockner Trail 50 km (GGT 50) leads towards the 2nd half of Grossglockner ULTRA-TRAIL® (GGUT). The track follows vast the trails of the so called "Glocknerrunde" along Austria's highest mountain, the Großglockner (3798 m) through the scenic landscape of National Park Hohe Tauern.

GGUT 50 k is a challenging trail running competition, leading mostly through difficult alpine territory, often higher than 2500 m. Expect 2 larger snowfields to cross, under bad weather conditions even more. For the largest part the track leads over trails (80 %), which are (partwise very) difficult. Bad weather conditions (low temperatures, rainfall, snow) make the race even harder.

Trails are in average very technical. The hardest parts will be the trails up to and down the high mountain passes: Kalser Tauern (2518 m) and Kapruner Törl (2639 m) as well as down from Rudolfshütte and (partwise) down from the Kapruner Hochgebirgsstauseen.


Your entry to the world of GGUT Start: Saturday 08.00, Berghotel Rudolfshütte, Uttendorf Finish: Schaufelberg Parkplatz, Kaprun

WEISSEE GLETSCHERWELT TRAIL (GWT 30) leads towards the last parts of the track of Grossglockner ULTRA-TRAIL® (GGUT). Start is at the dam of Weissee, close to Berghotel Rudolfshütte (2315 m). Transport with cable car to Rudolfshütte is possible from 07.00 and is free for all participants (just show your bib). Starting from magnificent Weissee a short climb to Rudolfshütte, then downhill towards Tauernmoos reservoir.

GWT 30 starts in 2300 m and has 1000 m of positive altitude climb and downhill of 2300 m. Although the hight difference is negative, GWT 30 is not just a walk. It is leading mostly through difficult alpine territory, often higher than 2500 m. Expect 1 larger snowfield to cross, under bad weather conditions even more. For the largest part the track leads over trails (90 %), which are (partwise very) difficult. Bad weather conditions (low temperatures, rainfall, snow) make the race even harder.

Trails are in average very technical. The hardest parts will be the trails down from Rudolfshütte, up to and down Kapruner Törl (2639 m) as well as (partwise) down from the Kapruner Hochgebirgsstauseen.


