The GWT (37 km, 1,500 m ascent) therefore marks the start of the race weekend in 2022: "The wonderful route of the Weissee Gletscherwelt Trail (GWT) leads the runners through a breath-taking mountain landscape with a view of glaciers and past clear reservoirs," explains Hubert Resch , Organizer of the Grossglockner ULTRA-TRAIL.
